Portland Copwatch (PCW) will be holding a three-part training cycle on the last Monday of June, July and August. It begins with our 1.5-hour Orientation on June 27, giving background on who we are, what we do, and what the heck all the police acronyms stand for (PJTTF? IPR?). On July 25 it's our 1.5-hour "Your Rights and the Police" Seminar, featuring an attorney, as we walk through the basics of what to do when stopped by the police. The third part is a 2.5-hour Copwatch training on how to safely and legally observe police, including how to file complaints.

Portland Copwatch is a project of Peace and Justice Works, a group promoting non-violent conflict resolution on local, national and international levels. PCW, founded in 1992, promotes police accountability through citizen action. Its goals include a Police Bureau free from corruption, brutality and racism.
